

C-5 An Unrecorded Species of the Genus *Dipoena* (Araneae : Theridiidae) from Korea.

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An unrecorded spider, *Dipoena japonica* Yoshida, 1985 is described on the basis of the material obtained from Kogum-do Isl., Korea. This species resembles to *D. amamiensis* (Yoshida, 1985), and *D. keumunensis* Paik, 1996 but is distinguished from the latter by epigynum, genital organ and black patterns on the abdomen.

C-6 Systematic Studies on Two Species of Genus *Apodemus* (Rodentia, Mammalia) from China and Korea : Multivariate Analyses of Morphometric Characters and mtDNA Restriction Fragments

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Morphometric characters and restriction fragments of mtDNA in two species of genus *Apodemus* from China and Korea were analyzed to reexamine their classification. Korean field mice, *Apodemus peninsulae* (subgenus *Sylvaemus*), appeared to be different from striped field mice, *Apodemus agrarius* (subgenus *Agrarius*), in their morphology and mtDNA restriction patterns as well. In three subspecies of *A. peninsulae* from China and Korea, *A. p. peninsulae* from Korea and *A. p. praetor* from northeastern provinces of China were similar with each other, but these two subspecies were different from subspecies *sowerbyi* from other regions of China, indicating that only two subspecies, *peninsulae* and *sowerbyi*, can be recognized in *A. peninsulae*, as noted by Corbet (1978). In six subspecies of *A. agrarius* from China and Korea, subspecies *coreae* from the Korean peninsula, subspecies *chejuensis* from Cheju island in Korea, and other four subspecies including *manchuricus*, *pallidior*, *ningpoensis*, and *insulaemus* from China were different with one another. Four subspecies of *A. agrarius* from China should be lumped into the eastern subspecies *ningpoensis*, as noted by Corbet (1978), but subspecies *coreae* and *chejuensis* are distinct from the subspecies *ningpoensis*, as noted by Koh (1991).
