

Four Unrecorded and a Little Known Species of Family Noctuidae (Insecta; Lepidoptera) in Korea

Noctuidae of Korea were enumerated with 961 species by Kononenko *et al.*(1998), and recently, further 5 species were added by Sohn *et al.* In the present study, four additional unrecorded and a little known species of Noctuidae are newly recognized from the Korean peninsula. Thus, the known Korean Noctuidae are 970 species. Newly recognized species including a little known species are following.

1. *Catoblemma obliquisigna* (Hampson) 지의꼬마밤나방(신칭)
2. *Lithacodia virescens* (Sugi) 꿀빛쌍무늬꼬마밤나방(신칭)
3. *Oligia ophiogramma* (Esper) 반월무늬밤나방(신칭)
4. *Anoratha costalis* Moore 잠자리수염나방(신칭)
5. *Spodoptera pectens* Guenée 남방빛살수염밤나방(specimen were newly found)
