

**1-7. The genus *Balanococcus* Williams (Sternorrhyncha:  
Pseudococcidae) of Korea**

Five species of the genus *Balanococcus* Williams (Sternorrhyncha: Pseudococcidae) from Korea were reviewed with descriptions and illustrations of full grown female. Among them, two species, *B. corpusenomis* sp. nov. and *B. corpusenomis* sp. nov., are described and a new combination, *B. bambusum* (Tang, 1992), comb. nov. is given. *B. orientalis* Danzig et Ivanova, 1976, which was previously recorded in Korea, has not been found during this study. A key to the Korean species is constructed on the base of morphological characters of adult females. This genus is characterized by a number of setae, multilocular pores, ducts, and circuli.
