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Random copolymer polyhydroxyalkanoates (PHAs) composed of short-chain length (SCL) and medium-chain length (MCL) monomers possess superior material properties compared with those consisting of only SCL or MCL monomer. Many microorganisms have been reported to produce such PHAs from various carbon sources. 2)

In this study, we report the results obtained with newly screened Pseudomonas sp. MBEL 6-19 producing SCL-MCL-PHA copolymers from sugars and fatty acids
