

# First report of *Feltiella acarisuga* Vallot (Diptera, Cecidomyiidae) in Korea

*Feltiella acarisuga*, a predatory gall midge preying upon spider mites is reported for the first time in Korea. It was found in Sachon, Gyongnam Province in a greenhouse living on Soybean heavily infested with *Tetranychus urticae* on October, 2003. This species are very useful biological control agent for spider mites on greenhouse vegetable crops.
